If the missing parts are small to medium sized, I like to do bonding. Little to no tooth structure is removed and the costs are relatively low with a good result.

If there is significant missing tooth structure and you need something stronger, bonded porcelain veneers or crowns are the best. These are also best if you want to improve the shape, alignment or color of the broken teeth.
